GLAUCOMA REPORT REQUIREMENTS

This examination must be performed by an Ophthalmologist and should include all relevant medical and surgical information on your present visual health, including where indicated:

- 1. condition of eye grounds (dilated funduscopic examination).
- 2. visual acuity measured for distant and near vision, without and with correction (if required), indicating vision in each eye separately and binocular acuity. Please give near vision in Times Roman Scale (N), or the equivalent metric scale.
- 3. if tropias or phorias are present in horizontal or vertical planes, please give measurement in prism diopters accompanied by opinion as to possibility of diplopia.
- 4. formal measurement of visual fields (Binocular Esterman).
- 5. refractive error which must be included for an estimate of equivalent spherical error. Cycloplegic refraction is desirable in borderline cases.
- 6. Any additional relevant information

It is suggested that you take this letter with you to your vision care specialist(s), so that they may be aware of Transport Canada requirements. This report will need to be updated yearly.
